Tim and Victor are very happy to share with their patients the changes that are taking place at Avondale Dental and how these changes will improve their service to you.





LASER WHITENING

Some people are satisfied with the results they get from brushing twice daily but this only removes surface staining from your teeth. Whitening your teeth is one of the easiest things you can do to improve your appearance and give you more confidence in your every day life.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

The procedure is simple and painless. You will be consulted by our dentist who will talk you through the procedure and discuss any concerns you may have. During this consultation, your dental health will be checked.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

During whitening treatment a gel is applied directly on your teeth and a xenon-halogen light is used to activate the gel and brighten your smile. This painless, effective technique takes just over an hour to whiten your teeth to their optimum colour. The active ingredient is hydrogen peroxide, which is very effective in removing tooth discolouration. With all teeth whitening procedures you may experience some sensitivity but this should only last for a short time. Using Sensodyne toothpaste for a short period can also help. Included with your treatment is a take home bleaching kit for touch-ups and further whitening if desired.
